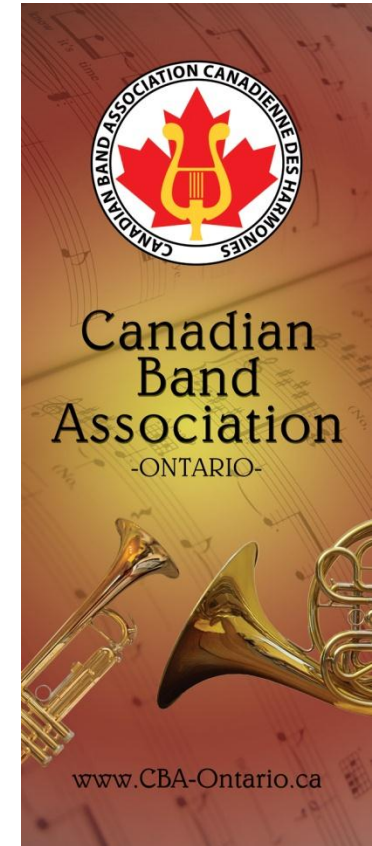

# WEB HOSTING

## What is the CBA (Ontario)?

The CBA (O) is a non-profit provincial service organization whose mission is to promote and develop the musical, educational and cultural value of bands and instrumental music in Ontario.

## Who Belongs to CBA (Ontario)?

The CBA (O) is an organization open to anyone interested in community music. The membership roster includes community and military bands; community orchestras; professional composers and clinicians; administrators; and members of the general public. Institutional and commercial memberships are also available to bands, booster groups, parent support groups, educational institutions and companies interested in having a voice in CBA (O)'s programs.

## Web Hosting

CBA (O) offers our member groups the opportunity to host their website on our web hosting service at no charge. This service provides:

- a. Unlimited storage,
- b. Unlimited bandwidth,
- c. Email forwarding and full email distribution list management. Such as [info@yourbandname.ca](mailto:info@yourbandname.ca)

## What is Web Hosting?

Many community bands want to raise their visibility both in their community and nationally. To accomplish that you will need your own website. There are a number of steps that must be taken to get 'online' with your band's web presence.

1. You need a Domain Name. That is the name that is used when someone is going to your website online. Like [www.yourbandname.ca](http://www.yourbandname.ca).
2. You need a web developer, someone who will turn your ideas into the appropriate internet code that displays when your site is accessed.
3. Finally, you require an internet service called Web/Internet Hosting. This is a company that provides the computer servers that hold your website and make it available to the internet. **This is the member benefit that CBA(ON) is providing to members at no charge.**

## What is a Domain Name?

Think of your Domain Name as the internet address that is used when people wish to view your website. A Domain Name must be unique in the world and is made up of a personalized name, like **yourbandname**, and a top level domain(TLD), like **.com, .ca, .org**. That would give you [www.yourbandname.ca](http://www.yourbandname.ca) as an example.

You acquire your unique Domain Name from an Internet Domain Registrar. The Registrar will provide the ability to search for your domain name to confirm if it is available and then register your Domain Name with the appropriate authority for an annual fee.

There are a large number of Domain Registrars available online. You will find that different Registrars charge a range of rates for your Domain Name and it will differ by the TLD that you select. Normally a .ca domain will be cheaper than a .com domain.

## How Do I Find a Domain Registrar?

CBA(O) does not require you to use a particular Domain Registrar. A Registrar we have used is [www.domainpeople.ca](http://www.domainpeople.ca)

## What Needs to be Done?

1. You need to be a member of the Canadian Band Association (Ontario). You can complete and mail the application on the back of this brochure or visit [www.cba-ontario.ca](http://www.cba-ontario.ca)
2. Contact the CBA(O) webmaster to confirm availability of the program. The webmaster will create a secure, private directory on our server that you will use to hold your website contents and code.
3. Acquire your Domain Name
4. Create your website. There are various templates and programs that make this an easier process. Your developer will determine the process they will use.
5. Upload your website code and contents to the space created for you in step 2. You will be able to test your site before you go 'live'.
6. When all your development work is completed advise the CBA(O) webmaster who will provide you with the required Domain Name Server (DNS) addresses that you will need to point your Domain to the CBA(O) server.
7. You are Online with your site, hosted by the CBA(O)!
