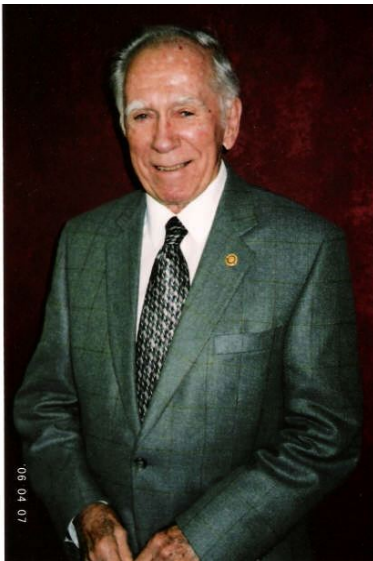

## **CBA ONTARIO'S OLDEST AND ACTIVE MEMBER ATTENDS APRIL 2006 MONTHLY BOARD MEETING**

### **A BIG WELCOME FROM THE BOARD TO FRED BUDD!!**



Fred Budd 23/4/06

Born Ottawa Apr. 11, 1916

Moved to Kitchener in 1926

My father played the euphonium and joined the Waterloo Band.

My father purchased an Albert system clarinet (\$35.00) and took me to meet C.F.Thiele, the bandmaster. Mr. Thiele taught me the basic music and I joined the Junior Boys Band at age twelve. Around age fifteen I was moved to the Senior Band and now played a current Boehm system clarinet, and after a few years moved up to the second chair, enjoying the Band and music very much.

I had received a couple of invitations to join the military band in Ottawa, so Thiele got me job at Mutual Life (Insurance now Clarica) to keep me in town. Jobs were scarce in 1935-1936

I joined the army from 1941 – 1942 and married a Preston girl and moved to Preston.

C.F.Thiele invited me into the CBA after I had conducted five years of Gilbert and Sullivan and also the Preston Legion Band.

To build up the twenty-five piece Preston Band I had to start teaching brass and woodwinds and Thiele was very helpful to get me started. In those days the High Schools had not started their instrumental programs, as they have today, so junior bands were the feeder for the future of community bands. We were fortunate to field a good band of fifty or so in the sixties and seventies and were quite successful, placing first and second at the CNE and KW and Stratford Kiwanis Festivals for a number of years.

I still kept up my clarinet and played three years with the KW Symphony, for many years with the Kitchener Operatic Society and also in Guelph. As for dance music, I played nine years at Leisure Lodge Night Club. I played with the Galt Kiltie Band and Ayr-Paris Band and did conducting with both of those bands.

I enjoyed the CBA ON very much. I was on the Board for sometime and served as the treasurer for three years. I am presently in the Hall of Fame for the City of Cambridge and the Hall of Fame for the Region of Waterloo.

I've enjoyed and learned considerably teaching young musicians (probably a couple of hundred) over seventy years. It's been fun and I have many wonderful memories. My favorite group of musicians has been the Wellington Winds with which I played for over ten years. They are dedicated, well trained, and perform professionally.

Thank you Michael for the great years and I'll never forget the *Shepherd on the Rock*.
